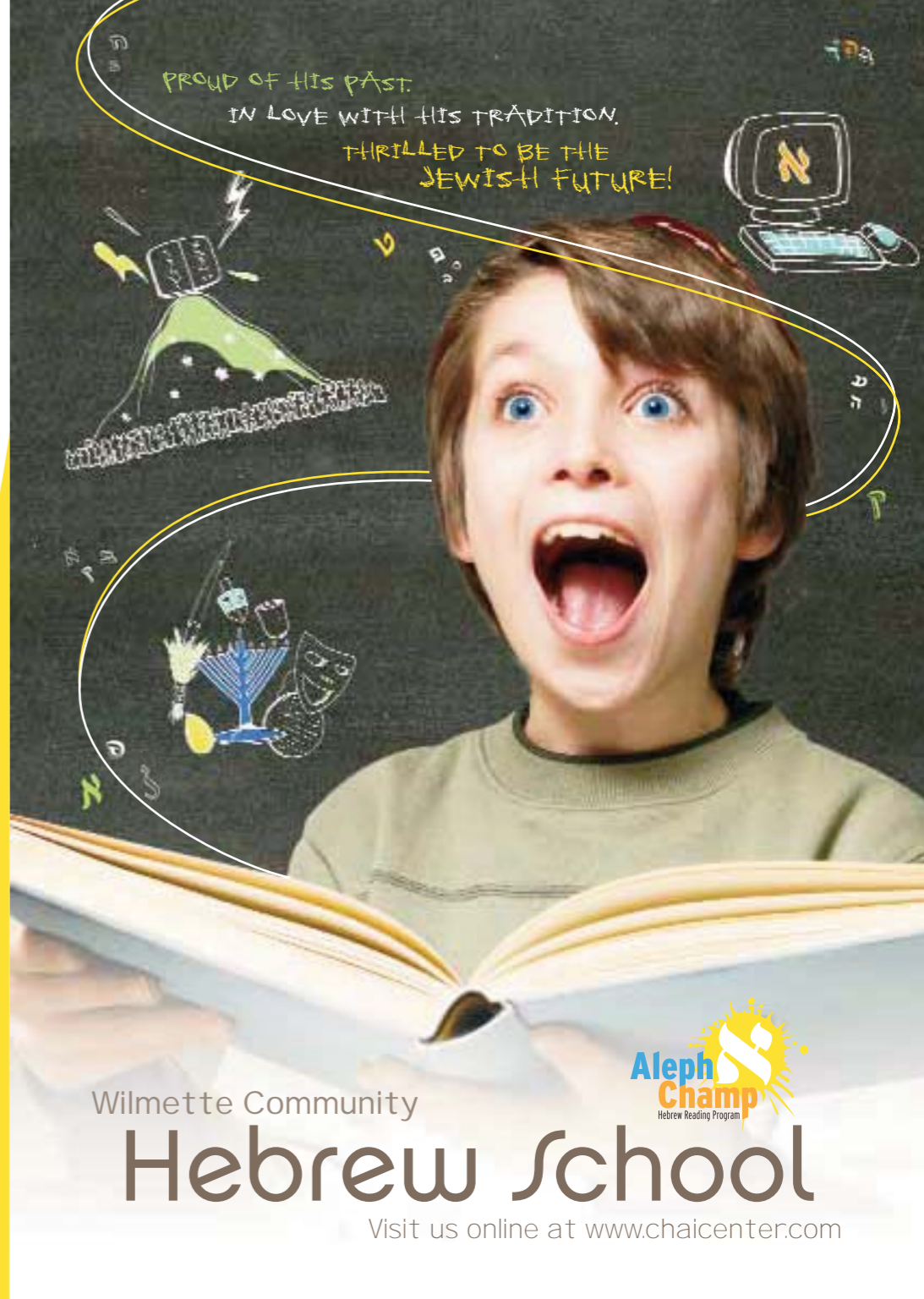

JUDAISM COMES ALIVE!

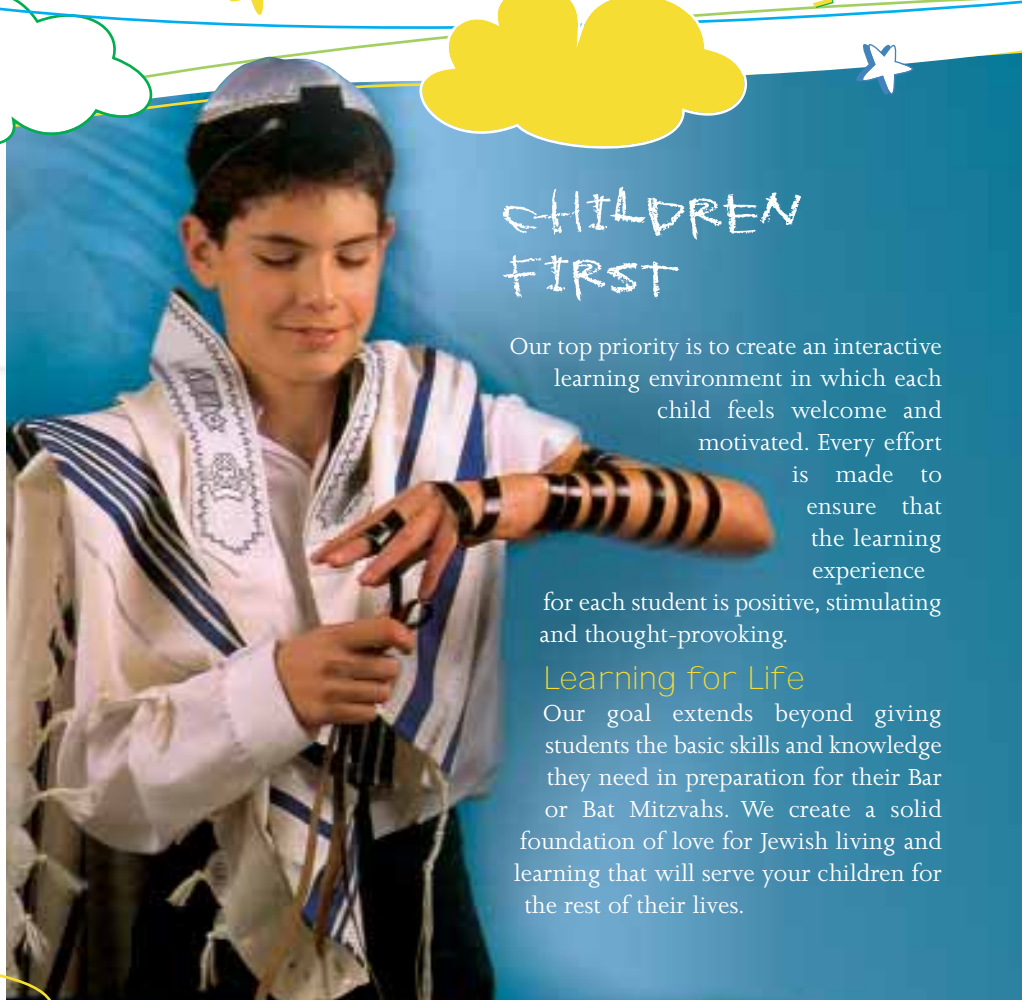
